ABSENTEE POLICY:

CONSISTENT ATTENDANCE IS VERY IMPORTANT TO THE STUDENTS AND TO THEIR SUCCESS IN THE PROGRAM. THEREFORE WE ASK PARENTAL SUPPORT IN SEEING THAT CHILDREN ARE PRESENT AND ON TIME FOR CLASS. IF A CHILD MUST BE TARDY OR ABSENT FROM CLASS, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN TO CONTACT THE CCD OFFICE BY PHONE. PLEASE CALL 347-6108 AND LEAVE A MESSAGE FOR MRS. ANNA McMAHAN, DIRECTOR. WE KNOW THAT LIFE IS FULL OF UNEXPECTED SITUATIONS AND UNDERSTAND HOWEVER IF A STUDENTS MISSES MORE THAN THREE DAYS OF CLASS IT COULD POSSIBLY RESULT IN A PHONE CALL OR MEETING WITH THE D.R.E. AND PASTOR TO DISCUSS THE BEST WAY TO MAKE UP THE MISSED CLASS TIME.

DRESS CODE:

ALL CHILDREN ATTENDING SAINT JOSEPH PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES ARE EXPECTED TO DRESS APPROPRIATE TO A CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT. HATS AND CAPS MAY NOT BE WORN DURING CLASS. NO CLEETS MAY BE WORN TO CLASS.

DISCIPLINE POLICY FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (CCD)

THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINE POLICY FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (CCD) HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE PASTOR.

THE CCD TEACHERS SET CLEAR AND RESPONSIBLE RULES FOR THE YEAR AT THE FIRST CLASS. IF A STUDENT IS NOT FOLLOWING THE RULES WE DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE TEACHER TELLS THE CHILD WHAT RULE THEY ARE NOT COMPLYING WITH.
2. THE TEACHER ASKS THE CHILD TO STOP THIS BEHAVIOR. IF THE CHILD DOES NOT COMPLY, THE CHILD IS BROUGHT BY THE TEACHER TO THE CCD OFFICE AND MRS. McMAHAN, DIRECTOR.

IF A CHILD IS SENT TO THE CCD OFFICE THIS IS CONSIDERED A SERIOUS DISCIPLINE PROBLEM. THIS WILL BE HANDLED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER.

FIRST SERIOUS DISCIPLINARY PROBLEM:

THE PARENT WILL RECEIVE A PHONE CALL FROM MRS. McMAHAN. THE CHILD WILL BE PRESENT WHEN THE CALL IS MADE. THE PHONE CALL WILL INCLUDE AN EXPLANATION OF THE PROBLEM. IF THE PHONE CALL IS UNABLE TO BE COMPLETED, THE PARENT WILL BE CALLED THE FOLLOWING MORNING (THURSDAY). THE CHILD WILL THEN WRITE A NOTE OF APOLOGY TO THE TEACHER AND CLASS. THE NOTE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE PARENT AND THE CHILD. THE CHILD MAY RETURN TO THE NEXT CLASS SESSION WITH THE NOTE.

SECOND SERIOUS DISCIPLINARY PROBLEM:

IF POSSIBLE, THE PARENT WILL RECEIVE A PHONE CALL FROM MRS. McMAHAN ASKING THAT THE CHILD BE PICKED UP FROM CCD ON THE EVENING THE PROBLEM OCCURRED. IN ORDER FOR THE STUDENT TO RETURN TO CCD, THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN WILL BE ASKED TO ACCOMPANY THE STUDENT TO THEIR CCD CLASS, AND REMAIN FOR THE ENTIRE CLASS.

PASTOR TEACHER, PARENT AND CHILD. ALL OPTIONS WILL BE DISCUSSED. ONE OF THE OPTIONS MAY BE EXPULSION. THIS WOULD MEAN THE CHILD WILL NOT BE WELCOMED BACK IN THE CLASS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE YEAR. EXPULSION IS A SERIOUS MATTER AND WILL BE USED IN EXTREME CASES WHEN EVERYTHING ELSE HAS FAILED.

THE PARENT HAS THE RIGHT TO APPEAL TO THE PASTOR WHEN EXPULSION IS BEING CONSIDERED.

OTHER POLICIES:

- Class time is 6:30-7:30 pm. Promptness to class will help us to get as much in each week as possible. Please have your child use the restroom before class time begins.
- Cell phones are not allowed in class! If student has their phone with them they MUST keep it put away.
- Appropriate dress for class is important. Please remember this is a "Church" event. Modesty is a MUST!
- Drop off and pick-up: Please enter parking lot through the gate closest to the church building and exit through the center gate. The gate closest to the school building will always be closed! DO NOT OPEN THIS GATE! Please do not drop your child off at the steps of the building. This is a safe area for the students to walk. If you

park on the street do not block the gate entrances. Note that the teachers will park up close to the building to help make a safe area for the students.

- The only doors that students should be using to enter and exit the building are the doors on the parking lot, all other doors are prohibited to exit out off for safety reasons.
- Grades Kindergarten through 2nd grades ask that the students be dropped off and picked up at the classroom door by adult or older sibling each night.
- Students are NOT allowed to enter classrooms before 6:30 when a teacher is not present. Students should NEVER be unsupervised in a classroom.
- When you come into the building to pick up please remember we are trying to have class. The noise from people visiting can be very distracting. I have asked the teachers to be respectful of your time and dismiss as close to 7:30 as possible. Fewer distractions will help!
- If student will be absent from class due to illness, please call the parish office. Parents or student should ask for missed work from the teacher upon return to class.
- Please do not send food or drinks to class. With all of the food allergies we ask that your child eat before class time. (Snacks may be brought in for the class with the teacher's approval.)
